Call for Proposals - Due Diligence Fund (DDF)



Contribute to the protection of human rights and the environment in agricultural supply chains. We are looking for promising, practical and innovative approaches to implementing corporate due diligence.

Who can apply?

Project proposals can be submitted by a **partnership between one or more private sector companies from Germany, as well as (at least) one non-profit actor**. Projects are funded with a sum of **up to 123,000 EUR over a period of up to 6 months**.

Which projects can be funded?

Projects,

- which meet the guiding principles of corporate due diligence to a substantial degree
- whose methodological approach is suitable for adaptation by other companies in the agricultural and food sector
- which show a particularly high potential to mitigate human rights and environmental risks effectively and sustainably
- which embed the planned measures in a process-oriented implementation logic and do not only achieve isolated effects

Your project proposal addresses one of INA's **focus commodities: banana, cotton, natural rubber, coffee, cocoa, orange juice, palm oil, soy, tea, spices**.

The implementation takes place in one or more **selected BMZ partner countries** (so-called „bilateral portfolio“, „reform partnerships“, „global partnerships“) **and** involves those **directly affected** in the countries mentioned.
